#### Price Risk



- Difficulties in Price Discovery
  - Illiquid track market
- Lack of viable hedging instruments
  - WA Futures Contract ??

## Counterparty Risk



- Selection of reliable sellers
  - MNCs
  - Australian giants
- Variable performance
- Differentiation of performance
  - I.P.
  - Flexibility
  - Crop information
  - Shipping slots
- Standardised contract



## Logistics Risk/Execution Risk

- Reliability as a major supplier
- Bottleneck
  - surge in demand vs fixed logistic capacity
- Shipping slots
- Inland logistics/storage
  - capacity limitation
  - high cost structure

- Loading control
